Garrett Forrs, Grade 7 has qualified to compete in the 2008 Massachusetts Geography Bee. Geography Bees were held in schools throughout the state to determine each school's Geography Bee winner. School-level winners then take a qualifying test, which is submitted to the National Geographic Society. The National Geographic Society invites the students with the top 100 scores from each of the 50 states, as well as the District of Columbia, and the U.S. territories schools to compete at the state level. The 2008 Massachusetts Geography Bee will be held at Clark University on Friday, April 4, 2008. The state winner will receive \$100.00, a globe, and a trip to Washington D.C. where he/she will represent Massachusetts in the national finals.
