1. As a condition for participation, each student’s parent or guardians will read and sign this student contract and will return it to the VHS site coordinator.

3. Students are expected to complete all their VHS assignments on time according to the VHS schedule.
4. Deadline to **drop classes is September 1st**. Student who drop a class in the VHS program after that time will be charged a \$150 fee for semester courses and \$300 for full year course to offset the fees already paid by St. Peter-Marian for that seat. A Withdraw Pass or Withdraw Fail will be placed on your transcript according to SPM Student Handbook.
